## College Matriculation, Readiness, and Persistence

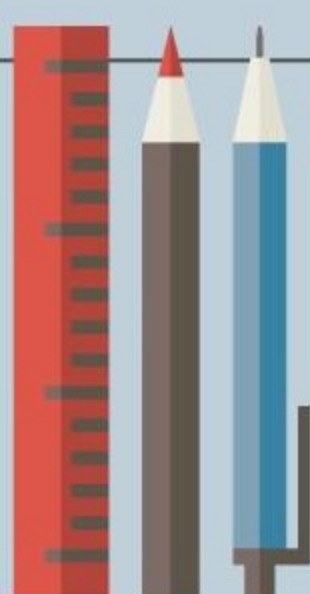


### MEMBERS OF THE CLASS OF 2016

**97%** of members of the Class of  
2015 reported that after at least  
one semester of college, they felt  
BCCS had prepared or overprepared  
them for college.

**OVER 80%** of BCCS graduates  
since 2010 have either graduated  
or are currently persisting in college.

## Advanced Placement (AP) Exams



BCCS students  
took a total of  
**173 AP EXAMS**  
– the most in a  
single year in  
school history.



**75% OF STUDENTS**  
who took the AP  
English Literature  
& Composition  
exam received  
a 3 or higher,  
qualifying them  
for college credit.



## MCAS [Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System]



**100%** of 9th Grade  
students scored Advanced  
or Proficient on the  
Physics MCAS exam.



**100%** of 10th Grade students  
scored Advanced or Proficient on  
the English Language Arts (ELA)  
MCAS exam.



**96%** of 10th Grade students  
scored Advanced or Proficient on  
the Math MCAS exam.
