Interns at Boston Collegiate will engage in a wide variety of tasks, ranging from: assisting classroom teachers in planning, preparation, and execution of instruction; supporting individual students through one-on-one tutoring; assisting in daily administrative tasks (planning field trips, monitoring afterschool activities, correcting final exams, proctoring standardized tests); taking on responsibility for long-range data gathering and analysis projects. In addition, our interns take an active role in our Summer Academy and provide direct academic support in our remediation program. Interns are an integral part of the school's success and help to wrap up the year with students, assist the leadership team in preparing for the upcoming year over the summer, and serve as point people for our

principals.

Our Summer Internships are paid at a rate of \$15/hr with a guaranteed 8 weeks of 30 hours of work. Weeks: June 2-6 (flex hours), June 9-13, June 16-20, June 23-27, July 7-11, July 14-18, July 1-25, July 28-Aug 1, Aug 4-8 (flex hours)
