

# Attendance Policy

April-June 2021

## General Attendance Policy

All students must attend over half of their scheduled classes to be marked present for the day, regardless of whether they are learning in-person or remotely. Absences will be marked as either unexcused or excused.

- The absence will be marked **unexcused** if it is non-medical or non-emergency related and students will not be allowed credit for the work missed (major assessments may be made up upon the discretion of the principal).
- The absence will be marked **excused** if it is medically related such as illness or a failed Ruvna screening, family emergency, religious holiday, etc. The student will be allowed to make up missed work.

## In-Person Attendance

Students who have signed up for in-person learning are expected to learn from the building everyday. If students opt to stay home they will be marked absent. Students will likely still have access to log-in remotely, however, they will be marked absent if it is not a COVID related absence (i.e. exposure, quarantine, etc.). Should a situation arise where there may be multiple absences due to COVID exposure, families should contact their pediatrician and our school nursing team; on subsequent days, the student may be permitted to access class remotely if capable.

## Remote Attendance

Students who have signed up for remote learning are expected to log-in to every class daily, and stay logged into the class for the duration of the class period. Students must attend more than half of their scheduled classes to be deemed present for the day and must attend over 85% of a class for that class to count toward present status.
