



## BOSTON COLLEGIATE CHARTER SCHOOL Girls Varsity Soccer Coach

BCCS was founded in 1998 with a simple yet ambitious mission: to prepare each student for college. We have grown from 120 students in grades 5 through 7 to almost 700 students in grades 5 through 12.

- 100% of students in BCCS's 12 graduating classes have been accepted to college. The majority of our students will be the first in their families to earn college degrees.
- In 2015, 100% of BCCS students scored Advanced or Proficient on the 10<sup>th</sup> grade ELA MCAS exam, and 97% of BCCS students scored Advanced or Proficient on the 10<sup>th</sup> grade Math MCAS. Additionally, 100% of BCCS students scored Advanced or Proficient on the 9<sup>th</sup> grade Physics MCAS exam.
- The school accepts students by random public lottery and has a waiting list of over 2,500 students.

The soccer season will run from August 26, 2019 through November 8, 2019. Preparation, practice planning, and meetings with the Athletic Director of BCCS will be required before the start of the season. Hours will be 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday for practice and roughly three hours on game days. Practices and home games will be held at Pope John Paul II field. Located at 757 Gallivan Boulevard, Dorchester. We are looking for teachers with any Varsity high school playing and/or coaching experience in any sport. The coaching stipend for a varsity sport will be up to \$3500. The Athletic Director will work with the head coach to determine as to whether an assistant coach could be beneficial for the team.

- Must hold a valid CPR/AED certification
