

TITLE IX FINAL RULE

The US Department of Education's Office for Civil Rights enforces Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (Title IX). Title IX protects people from discrimination based on sex in education programs or activities that receive federal financial assistance.

On May 6, 2020, the Department of Education (DOE) issued its Final Rule adopting amended regulations for Title IX. The updated regulations impose important legal obligations on schools. These changes take effect August 14, 2020.

The Final Rule was the first full rule-making on a major Title IX issue since 1975, and the only one ever dedicated to sexual harassment. Title IX changes apply to sexual harassment complaints involving both students and employees.
